2. Setup

Downloading the App

The Connect FX app is available from the Google Play Store or the Apple App Store. The WELL CONNECT wireless transceiver is not required at the time of downloading or installing the app, but it is required to control lights. For more information about downloading and installing apps onto your mobile device, see the documentation that came with your mobile device.

Connecting Products to WELL CONNECT

Mode

The Mode option permits users to select a control protocol through which the ConnectFX will connect with a product. To set the protocol that functions with the Connect FX app, follow the instructions below.

APP Mode

The WELL CONNECT can connect to a product via APP Mode. It is first necessary to connect a mobile device to the WELL CONNECT via Bluetooth. For further instructions on how to connect the WELL CONNECT to the app, see Connecting to the WELL CONNECT Via Bluetooth.

Once mobile device is connected to the WELL CONNECT, APP Mode control is possible. To connect and control products in this mode:

- 1. Ensure that the fixture to be paired is set to receive wireless signal from the WELL Connect.
- 2. On the WELL CONNECT, navigate the main menu to select the Mode option.
- 3. In the Mode menu, select APP Mode.
- 4. Once **APP Mode** is selected, it will be possible to connect and control the desired fixture via the mobile device.

Linking

Once a protocol has been selected, it may be necessary to link the WELL CONNECT box to a product. to link a product to the ConnectFX:

- 1. Go to the **Linking** main menu.
- 2. Select Link or Unlink.



The Linking function may also serve as a Receive Reset function.



Connecting to the WELL CONNECT Via Bluetooth


The WELL CONNECT generates a Bluetooth signal, which a mobile device running the Connect FX app must connect to in order to control any lights. To connect to the integrated Bluetooth using the Connect FX app:

- 1. Hold **<PWR>** for 3 seconds to power on the WELL CONNECT.
- 2. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on the mobile device.
- On the Connect FX app, select the **Home** tab. The app will display an "Offline" screen if a Bluetooth connection is not established.






4. Select the **Off** button to change status to **On**.




Allow the Connect FX app to access the device's location by selecting While using the app or Only this time.






6. Select Allow to permit the app to find nearby devices.



 If the existing project on the WELL CONNECT differs from the project on the user's mobile device, the Connect FX app will prompt the user to either Copy project from box, or Overwrite project on box.







Copying the project from the box will allow users to view/edit the existing show on the box, while Overwriting the project on the box will allow users to create a new show on the App and save it over the existing show on the box.
